

Building a team of campus missionaries

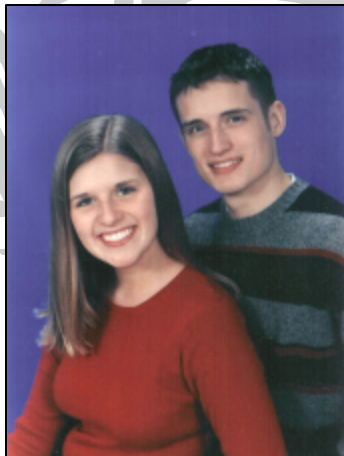
